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NATIONAL TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP AT HILTON HEAD, SC. (10/23-10/25)

Qualifying:

Players finishing the season in the top ten (and ties) in the Champ, A, B Flights of a Local Tour's points standings, qualify for the National Tour Championship. Players finishing the season in the top 15 for C Flight qualify for the National Tour Championship. *The D Flight will allow only the top five players in each tour to qualify for the National Tour Championship.* To be eligible for the Tour National Championship, players must have competed and returned valid scores for at least 4 tournament rounds. If a player chooses to move down a flight during the season, that player must play 3 rounds in the lower flight (after movement) to qualify to play in the lower flight at Nationals. As stated earlier, all requests to move down a flight must be made before the local tour's last three season rounds or by August 31. Qualification does not guarantee a spot in the Tour Championship field. Each flight has a maximum field size and players will be entered on a first come basis. When the field is full, the flight will be shut down to additional players regardless of local point's standings.

TIEBREAKERS

All first place ties will be decided by sudden-death playoff on the course.

For all other places the ties are broken as follows: Day 3 total, Day 2 total, Day 1 total, Day 3 back nine, Day 3 front nine, Day 2 back nine, Day 2 front nine, Day 1 back nine, Day 1 front nine.

TEAM CUP COMPETITION

Team Cup score is calculated from the best 2 scores from each flight each day. All five flights then are added up from all three days for an overall total winning tour/city. All tours must have at least 2 players in each flight to be represented as a team in Hilton Head.

2020 TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP SPECIFIC RULES:

- 1. ONE BALL RULE THE ENTIRE THREE DAYS. (ONE BALL RULE DETAILS EMAILED TO ALL ENTERED PLAYERS BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT BEGINS)
- 2. RANGE FINDERS ALLOWED.
- 3. <u>CADDIES ARE NOT ALLOWED.</u>
